A seasoned race winner

In the latest episode of the podcast, Sue Stockdale talks to Ross Hyett, who has been on the podium in motorsport over 150 times and has raced over 60 different purpose-built racing cars.

Hyett shares some of his memories from racing in the Le Mans 24 Hour race, including how he managed to drive with a shard of glass in his eye down the Mulsanne Strait...and survive.
